

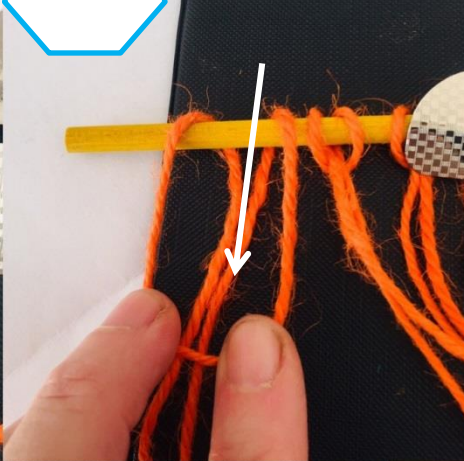
How to do the Reverse Larks Head Knot and Larks Head Knot



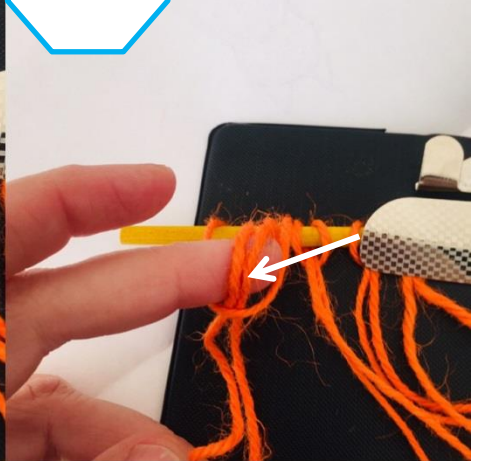

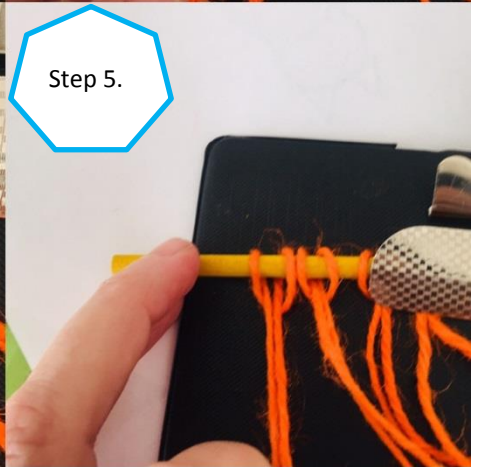

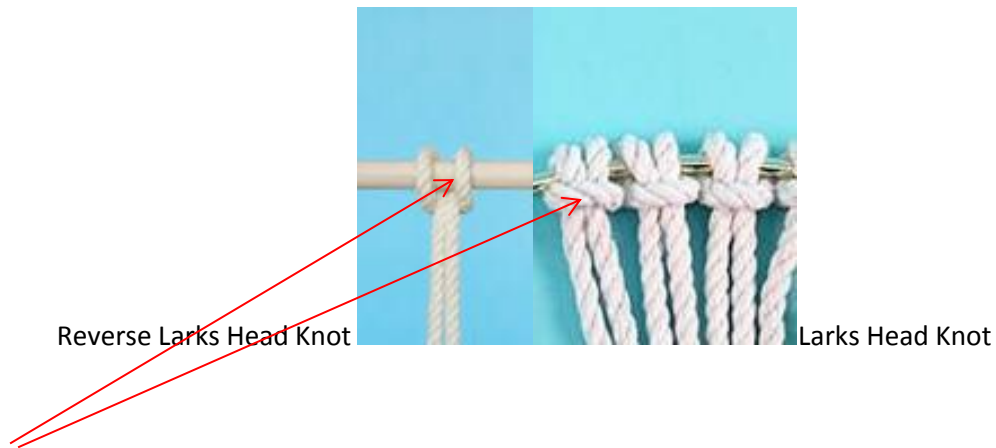

REVERSE LARKS HEAD KNOT





The only difference to this is that the working rope. One will at the back and the other at the front.

*Rope/twine/cord - Will be known as **rope** hereafter.

REVERSE LARKS HEAD KNOT - I have personally found this way easier and that is why I have shown the step by step first.

Step 1.

Fold your rope in half, pull the loop under the dowel rod. We will call the loop the working rope.

Step 2.

Pull the working rope over the dowel rod.

Step 3 & 4.

Bring the two ends through the hoop and pull them through.

Step 5.

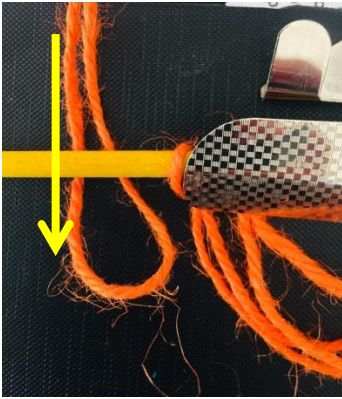
Pull the two ends so that the larks head knot is tight against the dowel rod.

You have now created your first reverse larks head knot.

LARKS HEAD KNOT – there are 2 ways of doing this with the same result.

Step 1.a

Fold your rope in half, pull the loop under the dowel rod, from the top, down. We will call the loop the working rope.

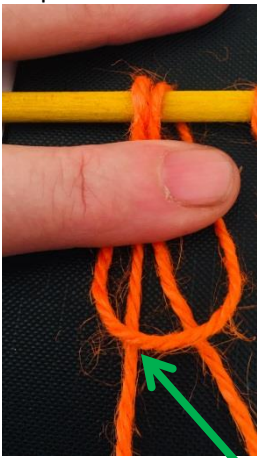


Step 2.a



Bring the working rope over the top of the rod.

Step 3.a



Pull the working rope through the loop.

Step 4.a

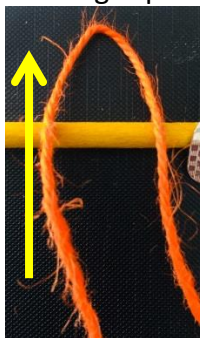


Pull the filler ropes tight to form your larks head knot.

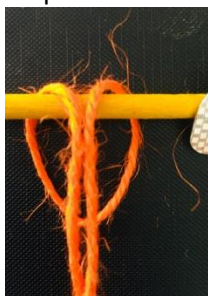
LARKS HEAD KNOT – there are 2 ways of doing this with the same result.

Step 1.b

Fold your rope in half, pull the loop over the dowel rod, from the bottom to top. We will call the loop the working rope.

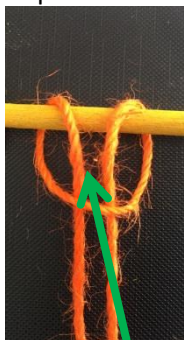


Step 2.b



Bring the working rope/loop over and under the rod.

Step 3.b

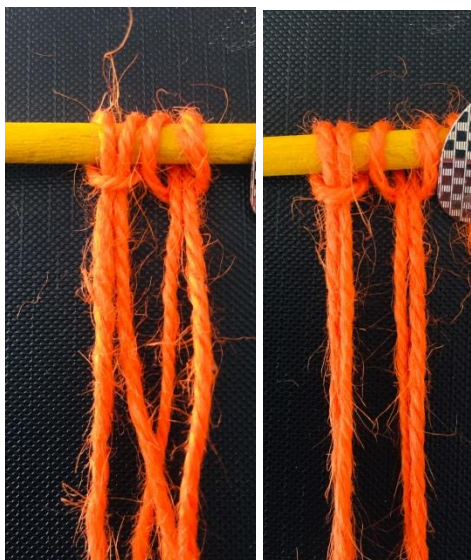


Pull the filler ropes through the loop.

Step 4.b



Pull the filler ropes and tighten to form your larks head knot.



These two larks head knot are using the two different ways, as you can see they look exactly the same. Find one that you feel comfortable with and that you like.
