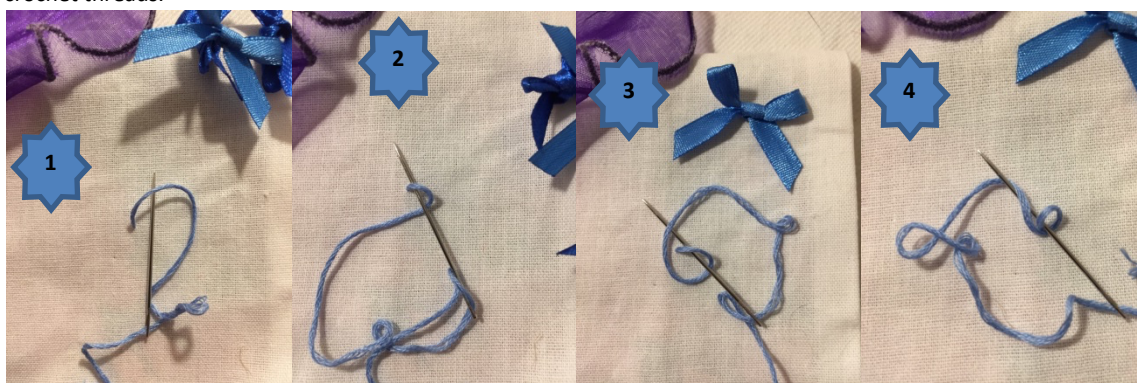


TIPS: Candlewicking – How to create a French Knot.

Note: There is another way of doing this, but I have found, especially for beginners this is the easier way, with causing tangles.

You can either create from the right side (blue Embroidery floss) or left side (red crochet thread) and use a variety of embroidery floss or crochet threads.



Step 1. – Create a loop with your embroidery floss to the right side, place your needle under the loop.

Step 2. – Wrap the thread around the needle.

Step 3 & 4. – Wrap the thread around the needle again.

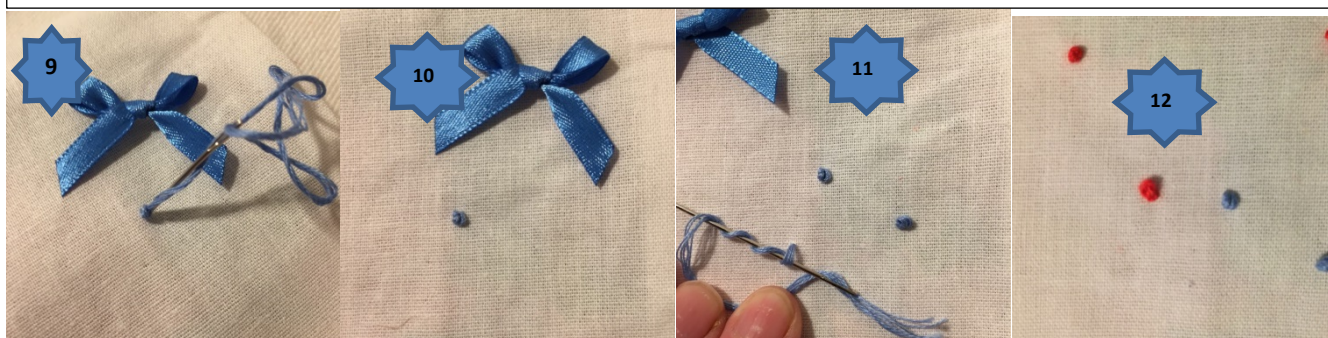


Step 5. – Pull your needle through the loops slowly.

Step 6 & 7. – As the loop starts getting smaller, gently place your finger nail on the thread and fabric, so that the loop closes properly and tightly.

Step 8. Pull the thread tight.

Step 3 & 4. – Wrap the thread around the needle again.



Step 9 & 10. – Place your needle through the centre of the knot and pull the needle and thread through to the back.

Finish off by knotting at the back. Continue with Steps 1 to 10 for next knot.

Step 11. The more wraps around the needle the bigger the knot.

Step 12. The French Knot.

Creating a French Knot from the left side and with crochet cotton. The steps are the same.
