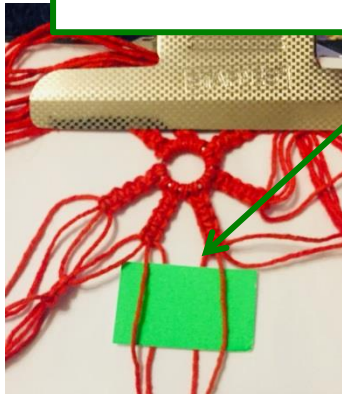
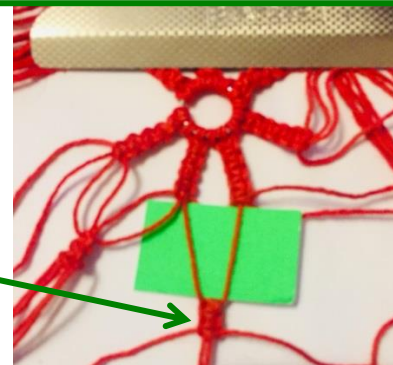


## SPACERS FOR MACRAME – make your own.

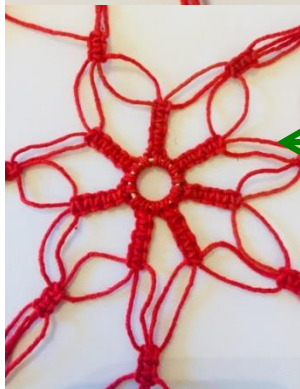
You can either use a spacer or your ruler for measuring the distances.  
TIP: Either purchase a spacer or create your own with stiff cardboard.  
The height will be the required distance and width is optional, I make mine between 5 to 7 cm.  
I have measurements of 2 cm and 1 ½ cm. So you would need to cut 2 “spacers” from your stiff card board. One will measure 2 cm by 6 cm (Size A) and the other will be 1 ½ cm by 6 cm (Size B). I have used Lumo Green Card board for visual purposes only, recycle a cardboard box or cereal box.



Place the two inner/holding cords under the “space and the two outer working cords over the “spacer”.  
Create 4 ASK.  
Remove the “spacer”.  
Repeat the process for all 7 groups.



If using a ruler. Measure from the top Square Knot, 2 cm (**blue arrow**) and then create your 4 ASK.  
Repeat the process for all 7 groups.



This is what it will look like.
